

Declaration of Intent for Equivalency Credits 2021-22

To earn academic equivalency credits at Puget Sound Skills Center (PSSC), a student must be enrolled in the Career & Technical Education (CTE) program listed below for a minimum of two semesters AND earn full credit with a "C" or above for BOTH semesters, as well as complete any additional academic work required to meet the curriculum requirements. The sending school counselor will determine how equivalency credit will meet graduation requirements. The declaration forms are due to the PSSC instructor within the first semester of a student's enrollment in the CTE program. A student may earn each of the available equivalency credits <u>one time only</u> over the course of their PSSC enrollment.
