

## Declaration of Intent for Equivalency Credits 2021-22 Fire Emergency Services

To earn academic equivalency credits at Puget Sound Skills Center (PSSC), a student must be enrolled in a Career & Technical Education (CTE) program for a minimum of two semesters AND earn full credit and a "C" or above. The sending school counselor will determine how equivalency credit will meet graduation requirements. The declaration forms are due to PSSC instructors within the first semester of a student's enrollment in a PSSC CTE program. Students may only apply "once" for each of the equivalency credits available.
